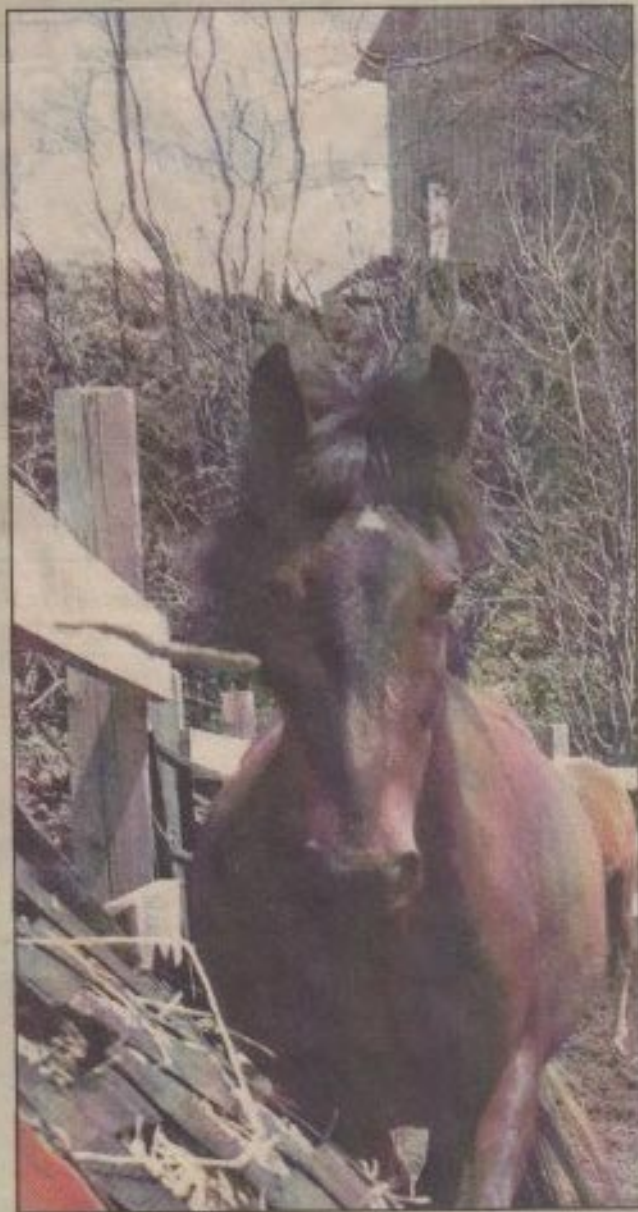


Meet Firefly, Rescued From Slaughter
